

## Intent

At Little London, our Geography curriculum aims to provide our children with a sense of awe and wonder about the world they live in. Our curriculum aims to enable children to develop the knowledge and skills to study the world around them, as well as to inspire a curiosity and fascination about the world and people within it. We hope to encourage pupils to become resourceful, active citizens who will have the skills to contribute to and improve the world around them.

## Implementation

For our children here in the heart of Leeds, comparisons to more rural areas within the local area and also to different regions around the world gives them an appreciation of where they are from, and an understanding of the interdependence of our world and how we are connected.

At our school, each year group is taught either two or three units of geography per year, to ensure skills are practiced and built upon. Units are taught either weekly within the half term or as a block. Units of work include an element of fieldwork either within the school grounds, the local area or further afield, to allow pupils opportunities to practice collecting and interpreting relevant data.

Pupils complete a knowledge catcher activity at the start of a unit. They annotate this at the end and also complete a short assessment, demonstrating their learnt knowledge.

SMSC is promoted in Geography as we prepare pupils for opportunities, responsibilities and experiences of later life.
