Hello!

Welcome back to school after the summer break! We hope you all had a restful break and we are looking forward to sharing what we have planned for your children over the course of their first half term in Year 5.

Our first topic this half term will be 'Ancient Egypt' and we will be reading 'Secrets of a Sun King' by Emma Carroll. We will be focusing on the discovery of the 'Valley of the Kings' in our history lessons and learning about past pharaohs, such as Tutankhamun. We will also be visiting the Leeds City Museum to handle Ancient Egyptian artefacts and visit their exhibition. If you would like to go in your own time, entry to the museum is free.

Writing:

We will be writing a setting description of an Ancient Egyptian tomb as well as a diary from the perspective of a slave.

Maths

In maths, we will begin to recap our knowledge of Roman Numerals, as well as focusing on Place Value and the four operations. Please continue to practise times tables with your child at home.

Reading:

All children will have their own reading book chosen at their reading level. We would like you to send your child to school each day with it, along with their planner. The children will also get to choose a pleasure read from our class library each week. Please take good care of all books sent home.

Please make sure that you sign your child's reading record in their planner at least 3 times a week in order to have their book changed.

Chromebooks

Please make sure your child's Chromebook is **charged every night** before they come to school. This is really important to ensure that they can access any learning that takes place whilst in school. Pupils are not allowed to share devices for safeguarding purposes.

Uniform

Please ensure that your child is wearing the correct school uniform, including school shoes or trainers that are completely black. On PE days, pupils must have an all-black PE kit, however on these days they can wear any colour trainers they wish. At the moment, the weather is very unpredictable so please ensure your child will be warm enough.
