COUNTRY TRAIL



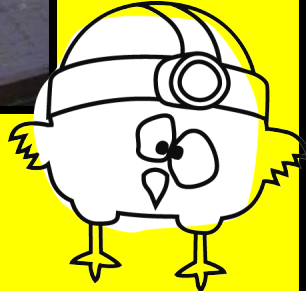
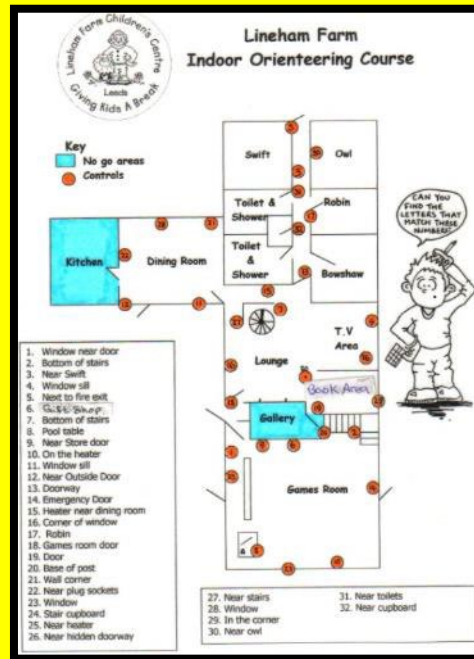
The country trail looks at map reading, having fun in the countryside, the country code, walking and wildlife spotting.

Children and young people get to run some energy off around the site against each other, learning about map reading and working together as a team.

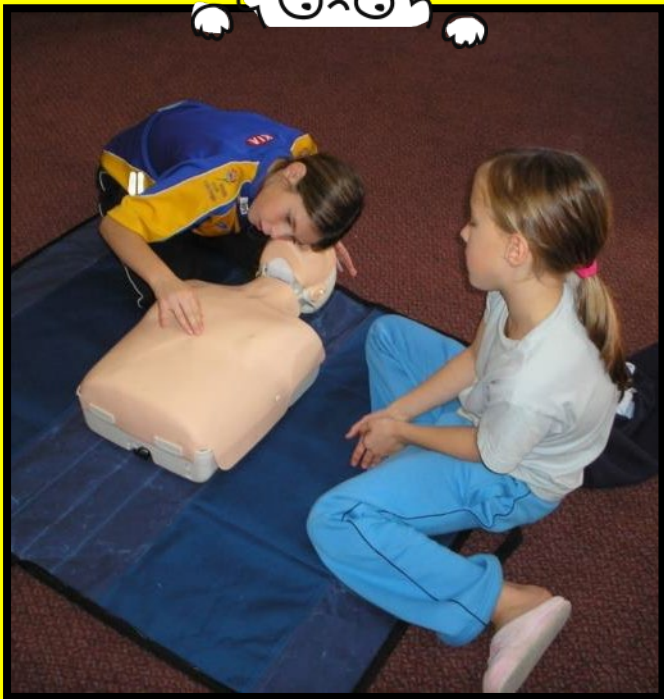

This is a great way to end your time at Lineham and brings together all the skills the children and young people have learnt.



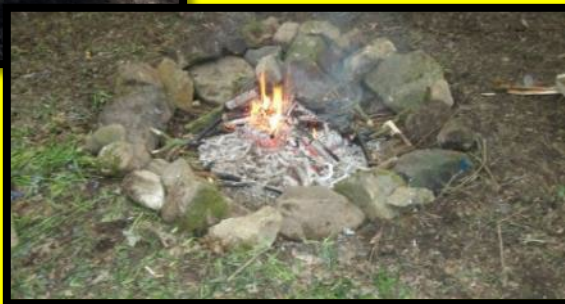
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EVENINGS

We tell children to always do as adults tell them - straight away

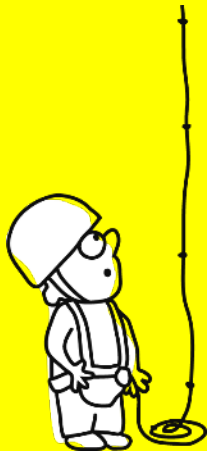




Lineham Farm - A Child Friendly Environment
